FOUNDATION JUMPING

You will learn the six separate components that compromise the performance of jumping and the importance of having a specific methodology in place for teaching your dog the mechanics of good jumping. Susan will expose you to several Foundation Grids with which you and your dog will practice these mechanics under her watchful eye. At the foundation level, there is initially no motion from the handler. You will either be recalling or sending the dog to a target.

PREREQUISITES: Dog should be at least one year old.

ADVANCED JUMPING (REPEATERS)

This workshop is an extension of the grid work done in Foundation Jumping. You will continue previous work with Set Point, Bounce, One-Stride, Progressive, and Bending grids and may be exposed to various new grids. If your dog is performing the Foundation grids with stability and speed, Susan may incrementally interject some handler movement into your exercises.
